tasks/responsibilities of a state

- ATFM IR 255/2010 lays down the requirements for ATFM in order to optimize the available capacity of the European air traffic management network and enhance ATFM processes.
- Governing implementation of ATFCM function in ECAC States
- Describes rules and responsibilities of different stakeholders involved in ATFM

- ☐ Airspace Users

- ☐ AIS

- ☐ ASM Entities

- ☐ Central and Local ATFM Units

- ☐ State NSA's

- ☐ SLOT Coordinators and Airport Managing Bodies

- ☐ Approved Agencies



tasks/responsibilities of a state

- Member States essential security and defense policy interests are safeguarded
- ATFM measures are based on principles laid down by ICAO
- Requires consistent procedures to be established for the cooperation between the parties involved in ATFM function = Collaborative Decision Making CDM
- IR requires that all involved are informed, and take part in decisions, with the interest of the Network in a first place.
- **For SE Asia:** In implementation of ATFM such hierarchy must exist and be clear and acceptable to all parties
- No central unit, but central data system



tasks/responsibilities of a state

- Member States shall ensure that a local ATFM unit is established and equipped to a common minimum level and established in each **designated area** within the single central unit for flow management
- Member States shall ensure that each designated area in the central unit for ATFM area of responsibility shall designate a local ATFM unit manager.
- The local ATFM unit manager shall be responsible for all ATFCM activities in the designated area and within its area of responsibility.
- FMP position in every local unit (ACC), and connected to NMOC



tasks/responsibilities of a state

- Responsibility is on State – NSA ensures implementation and monitoring
- Audits during implementation, documentation, working together with NSA to achieve best situation for Network and Users – own example
- Initially, some requirements unclear = Responsibilities Document
- ATFM Function in each State described in AIP ENR1.9
