  - Update of training, competency and performance assessment of AIS personnel to the needs of transition to AIM for digital data sets and eAIP.



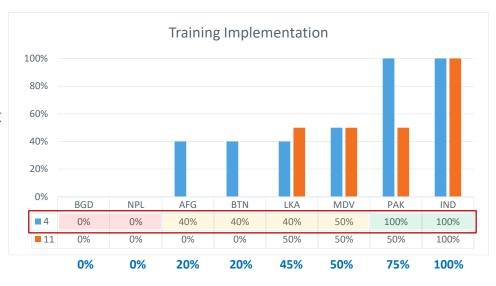

#### Development of Competency Requirement for AIS Personnel

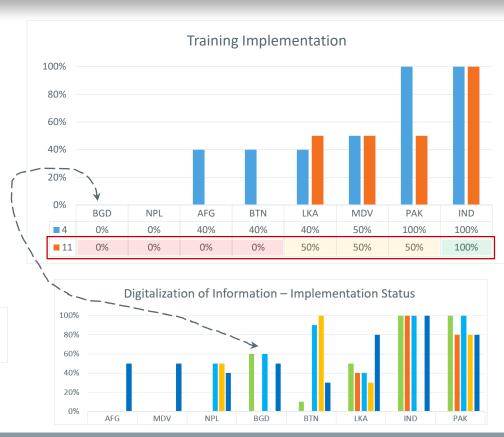
- Overall implementation: 46%

# Update of training, competency and performance assessment of AIS personnel

- Overall implementation: 31%
- Highest priority in South Asia
  - Bangladesh, Nepal
  - Afghanistan, Bhutan







ICAO STD

3.6.4 Within the context of the established quality management system, the competencies and the associated knowledge, skills and abilities required for each function shall be identified, and personnel assigned to perform those functions shall be appropriately trained.

Processes shall be in place to ensure that personnel possess the competencies required to perform specific assigned functions.

Appropriate records shall be maintained so that the qualifications of personnel can be confirmed.

**Initial and periodic assessments** shall be established that require personnel to demonstrate the required competencies.

- Competencies shall be identified
- Personnel shall be appropriately trained
- Appropriate records shall be maintained
- Initial and periodic assessments shall be established
- Training development



#### How to train AIS personnel?

- Send your staff to training centre (overseas, conducted by other organizations)
  - Course content should comply with determined competencies
  - Training should be competency based training
- Develop your own Training system
  - Guidance Manual for AIS in the Asia/Pacific Region

- Organizational knowledge
  - internal sources (knowledge gained from experience, lessons learned from failures etc.)
  - external sources (standards, academia, conferences, gathering knowledge from customer)
- Corrective actions
- Audit (external and internal)
- Proposal/suggestions
  - Evaluation Form
  - Questionnaire



#### Training should be

- Conducted
  - by Qualified Instructor
  - at Aeronautical Information Service (AIS)
  - at Civil Aviation Training Centre (CATC)
- Evaluated by
  - Qualified Examiner or Assessor
  - Written exam (paper based or online)
  - Practical exam (skills, attitudes)
- Regulated/Supervised by
  - Safety Oversight

Competency based
Instructor dependent **Material** dependent
